by a New England Author or with a New England Setting*

### CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

PEN New England is now accepting submissions for the L.L. Winship / PEN New England Awards for books published in 2009. The award was established by The Boston Globe in 1975, and co-sponsored by PEN New England (PEN American's New England chapter).

Three prizes will be awarded: best book of fiction, nonfiction, and poetry. **Eligible entries must be by New England authors or books with a New England topic or setting.**

Last year's L. L. Winship / PEN winners were Margo Livesey for *The House on Fortune Street*, Patrick Tracey for *Stalking Irish Madness*, and Nancy K. Pearson for *Two Minutes of Light*.

Previous winners of the L.L. Winship Award include E.B. White, Andre Dubus, Susan Cheever, Tracy Kidder, Mary Oliver, Susan Quinn, Jill Ker Conway, Jan Swafford, Anita Shreve, Edward Delaney, Swanee Hunt, Kevin Goodan, Stanley Kunitz, Leo Damrosch, Jennifer Haigh, K.C. The award will be presented, along with the Hemingway Foundation/PEN Award, at the John F. Kennedy Library in Boston on Sunday, March 28, 2010.

**No electronic submissions, e-books, or self-published books are eligible.**
