#### THE PEN NEW ENGLAND/L. L. WINSHIP AWARDS

*Awarded for Best Books of Fiction, Nonfiction, and Poetry  
by a New England Author or with a New England Setting*

PEN New England is now accepting submissions for the L.L. Winship / PEN New England Awards for books published in 2010. The award was established by The Boston Globe in 1975, and co-sponsored by PEN New England (PEN American's New England chapter).

Three prizes will be awarded for: best book of fiction, nonfiction, and poetry. **Eligible entries must be by New England authors or books with a New England topic or setting.**
